The course is an opportunity for prospective students of Queen's to gain study skills that will give them confidence for studying theology at Higher Education (HE) level. Participants will be offered a framework for studying Christian theology, ministry and mission in order to enable them to engage in critical thinking and theological reflection. There will be an emphasis on Black theology. The sessions will be lively and interactive, and participants will be able to 'taste' life at Queen's with staff and students on campus. Participants will be encouraged to attend all sessions in order to maximize the opportunity of being equipped for HE studies in the near future. The commitment for attendance will include **two Saturdays (9.30am – 6pm) and four consecutive Wednesday evenings (6.45pm – 9.00pm)**. The £60 fee for all participants includes meals and refreshments.

**By the end of the course, participants will be able to:**

- Reflect on how scripture, spirituality and tradition can all be sources of Christian theology
- Evaluate the value of different approaches to the task of theological study and reflection
- Carry out a guided task that will involve independent enquiry and theological reflection
